Dear Mr. Sumner

A thousand thanks for

worried preparing
my letters, and

sent me since which I

know does me more
god than anything,
especially as, these two
last occasions, I have
tried rowing again —
I used to row a little
with the Sargeants in
the room at Flatman,
you know. I find
my hand is quite mended
as far as using it
is concerned. The
bone projects a little
but there is a sort of

lump over the knuckle,
but this lets me think is
because the muscles
across the hand have
not get grown back
thoroughly.
