hard-working, and ambitious student I've worked with my 30 years at Colby," said the William A. Rogers Professor of Physics Charles Conover, Bui's thesis advisor. "He is a once-in-a-lifetime student." This summer, the Phi Beta Kappa scholar is headed to MIT for a Ph.D. program in experimental atomic physics, continuing the research he conducted with Conover on ultracold atoms.
