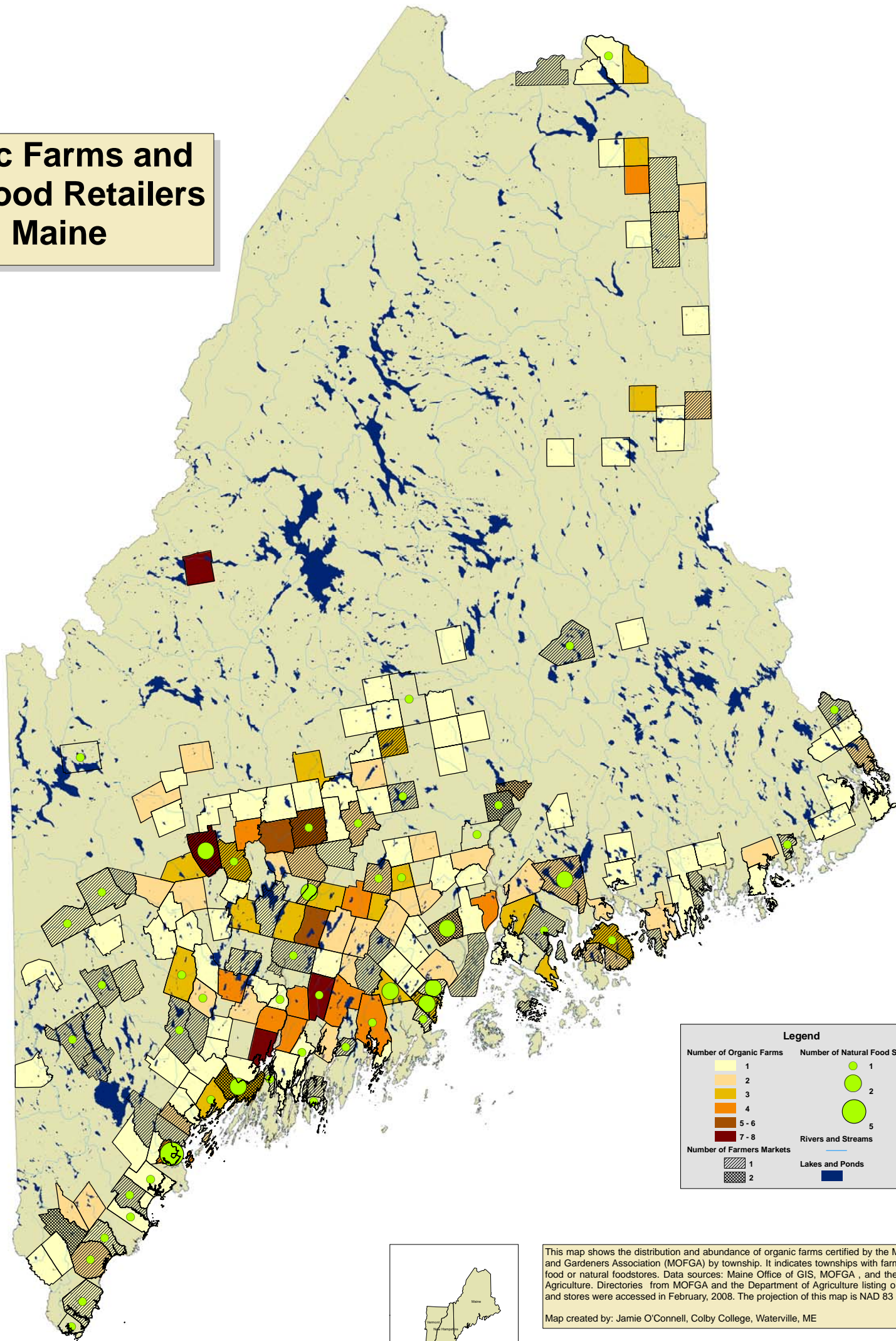
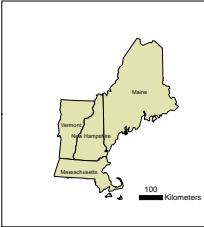


# Organic Farms and Local Food Retailers in Maine
